The **submission of abstracts** for the proposed presentations and posters relating to the topics of the conference is before **13 November 2016**. The abstracts and registration form will be edited and submitted as e-mail attachments, following the instructions given in the web page of the conference.

Notification of **abstract acceptance** will be emailed to the contact authors by **16 November**.

The **submission of full paper** is due before **20 November 2016**. Papers will be blind cross-evaluated by two reviewers. Further guidelines concerning the format of the full papers are available on the Conference website.

Accepted full papers presented by their author(s) will be **published** in a special number of the journal **Bulletin of the Polytechnic Institute of Iasi, Mathematics. Theoretical Mechanics. Physics** (recognized by CNCSIS, as a B+ category journal).

Registration fee is:

- **35 EUR** - foreign participants;
- **150 RON** - Romanian participants;
- **100 RON** – teachers from preuniversitary schools;
- **75 RON**- students, master and PhD students.

The registration fee includes:

- admission to the conference sessions, the poster area and the exhibition conference materials;
- coffee breaks during the conference days;
- refreshments.

An additional fee will be charged for those who wish to attend to the conference party or to the turistic attractions form Iasi.
